

RODS & RELICS OF LINCOLN HILLS CAR CLUB BY-LAWS

I. MISSION STATEMENT

The Rods & Relics Of Lincoln Hills Car Club is a non-profit organization formed by individuals with an interest in the restoration, preservation, and enjoyment of collector vehicles, such as Original, Antiques, Classics, Streets Rods, Muscle Cars, Special Interest, Modified, and other American or American-powered vehicles 1972 and older. We use this strong interest to facilitate fund raising and community service to non-profit organizations and people in need.

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of the Club shall be to perpetuate the interest in all collector vehicles, encourage and facilitate the camaraderie of group touring and outings, including attending car shows together, sharing information about upcoming car events, sponsoring Club events, and sharing in the fun and fellowship of our collector car hobby.

III. REGULAR MEMBERSHIP

All car owners with currently registered and operating American-made and American-powered vehicles manufactured in 1972 or before or replicas of such a vehicle are eligible to be regular members of this Club. Application for membership will be accepted after the prospective member has attended two meetings. The prospective member shall be given a copy of the By-Laws to read and sign. The prospective member shall not be invited to the third meeting and the membership shall vote on acceptance. The Membership Director will notify the applicant of the results by phone, E-mail, or mail prior to the next General Business Meeting. The applicant will become a regular member after he/she pays the dues. Each regular member must attend a minimum of four Club promoted events each calendar year, with his/her vehicle. For all new regular members, the minimum attendance and other Club requirements begin at the time the new member is voted in and has paid his/her Club dues.

IV. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Associate Membership is available to anyone who has been a member in good standing for a minimum of two years but no longer has an eligible vehicle. Associate Members have the same rights and responsibilities as regular members but are not eligible to hold office or vote. They may, however, serve on committees.

V. MONTHLY MEETINGS

Meetings will be held on the third Thursday of each month. Members will receive E-mail notification or written notice of each meeting date, time, and place as a reminder. Members shall be required to attend at least one meeting per quarter to maintain membership. The Membership Director shall contact members not meeting this requirement. Extraordinary reasons for non-attendance will be considered. The Club members shall vote to retain those members not meeting the above requirement.

VI. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors will be composed of seven members: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Activities Director, Membership Director, and Member-At-Large.

VII. TERMS OF SERVICE

The Board of Directors shall be elected by the general membership to specific open positions and shall serve a two-year term. Three of the positions will expire on even numbered years and four of the positions will expire on odd numbered years. The election shall occur in February with the new Board members taking office on April 1. If a Board member resigns from the Board, a special election will be held to fill that position. Should the President resign, that position shall be filled by the Vice President.

VIII. OPERATING RULES

These rules define the duties of the Board of Directors, Additional Positions, Voting, Fiscal Year, Financial, Rules of Conduct For All Meetings, and Rules Of The Road For Club Promoted Events.
